Dear Students

The Executive Management Committee met today, the 17th January 2018 to consider the following concerns raised the SRC.

1. Application status not changing

The Faculties have been requested to look into the matter and ensure that all outstanding application statuses are dully updated as a matter of urgency.

2. Approved students not registered

This matter is being discussed with the Deans with a view to review the set quotas to accommodate the affected students. Once this is finalized, a special arrangement will be made to accommodate the affected students by tomorrow, the 18th January 2018.

3. Late application forms are not given attention

These forms are being processed and where applicants qualify, they are being invited to register.

4. Inefficiency in extended programmes

The University still awaits the approval from the Department of Higher Education and Training, regarding this matter and REMINDERS have also been sent to the DHET. Once a response shall have been received for a go ahead, the matter will be attended to as per the directive of the DHET.

5. Temporary accommodation

Management has directed the residence department to continue providing temporary accommodation while the registration process of the affected students is finalised.

CONCLUSION


May we advise the student body that we, the Management are doing the best we can to resolve whatever challenges are confronting students.
