

NOTICE TO STUDENTS 2019 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The information below serves as a guide for the 2019 registration process for both prospective and returning VUT students.

Registration date: 8 – 10 January 2018:

Prospective students who have been given a firm offer (National and International students)

Registration of all successful student who applied in the previous year and whose application is successful will commence on the **8 until 10 January 2019**. These prospective students have been informed that their application is successful and sent information regarding registration. Should you not report on the dedicated days, note that you will forfeit your space.

Registration date 14 -16 January 2019:

Prospective students who did matric in 2018

This group of students will be notified via sms alternatively they can check their application status on the VUT website. Should your application be successful, you will need to present yourself for registration on the **14 to the 16 January 2019. Make sure you report on these days or we will offer your place to another prospective student.**

If your application is still pending, do not report for registration.

Late Admission placements (17 – 18 January 2019)

All students that have not applied for admission will be given a one-page application form. They need to complete this form, attaché statement of results and a certified copy of ID. They need to drop this form at thee dedicated marque with the registration official. The will be informed to only report when they are contacted to do so. All late admissions will be done on the 17 and 18 January 2019 for programs where space is still available. Should you not here from us, please consider your application unsuccessful.

All admissions, results will be verified by the Registration official before registration can take place.

Unsuccessful Applicants

Should your application **not be successful** for both application choices, you may be considered to the extended programs. All admission is based on meeting the set admission criteria and availability of spaces in programs. If you still are not successful (including for extended programs) you are advised to use the department of Higher Education CACH service for other alternatives. Registration date: 21 -25 January 2019

New B.Tech, and Advanced Diplomas and Returning students (Both National and International students).

All new BTECH and Advance diploma students are to report for registration with returning students on the 21 - 25 and 28 -30 January 2018.

Note that no registration will take place on the 31 January due to data synchronization procedures. For more information on the processes to follow when registering visit the VUT Website and click the link 2019 Registrations.

NSFAS RECIPIENTS:

Students should take note of the following registration arrangements for all first-year students for 2019:

1. NSFAS grant recipients will be allowed to register without making an upfront payment or registration fee. (This dispensation is in accordance with the prescripts of the NSFAS rules and regulations).
2. Confirmed bursary holders will equally be allowed to register without making upfront payment or registration fee.
3. All other applicants without a NSFAS grant or a bursary will be required to make an upfront registration fee payment of R2, 000 for non-residents and R4, 000 for residents.
4. Students who were enrolled in extended programmes in 2018, and are enrolling for the main-stream programmes in 2019, will be treated as first-entering students.
