1. Certificate copy of South African green bar-coded ID document
2. Certified copy of Grade 11 or latest Grade 12 report (e.g. June examination)
3. Proof of address (Not compulsory)

4. Application fee of R100.00. Application forms without proof of payment will not be accepted.
