LAST CHANCE TO COMPLETE 2020 ACADEMIC YEAR

1. The University Management would like to thank many of our students who have managed to successfully complete the year 2020 albeit under an extreme, abnormal and threatening Covid-19 pandemic environment.
2. To ensure that no one is left behind, The Vaal University of Technology (VUT) is offering all students that have not participated in teaching and learning in either semester 1 or 2 or the year modules, after lockdown, a final chance to participate in teaching learning and assessment.
3. VUT Management would like to ensure that all our students have a fair chance of completing the 2020 academic year.
4. We are contacting students directly, but we might not have your current details.
5. If you have been inactive in any learning period after the lockdown of the university in March 2020 and would like to take advantage of a final chance to complete this year's work, please contact your lecturer before 12 December 2020.
6. All students falling into this category will be issued with a return to campus (RTC) permits for January and February 2021.
7. All permits issued in 2020 are **ONLY** valid until 15 December 2020.
8. New permits will be issued in accordance with the academic year plan for 2021.
9. VUT residences will be open on 13 January 2021 to admit students with valid residence permits to complete the academic year.
10. All student's intake will be in line with the COVID -19 protocols and procedures.
11. Students that have proof of compelling academic commitments to return to campus earlier than 13 January 2021 should immediately inform the residence office so that alternative arrangement are made on or before 11 December 2020.
12. VUT Management have communicated with various landlords to expect students to return to residences from 13 January 2021.
