VUT has 4 Faculties: Management Sciences, Applied & Computer Sciences, Human Sciences as well as Engineering & Technology. VUT offers qualification mix that meet the needs of the broader community through blended teaching and learning methods.

An extension of the Vanderbijlpark Campus is the VUT Southern Gauteng Science and Technology Park (VUT SGSTP) situated in Sebokeng, through which the institution promotes technological innovation and technology transfer in the region. This technology initiatives are aimed at supporting industry and the community with innovation and link all training needs to be in line with the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR).

The Science Park has been donating Idea to Product (I2P) Labs to secondary schools that specialises in Mathematics and Science to advance skills training in these areas. Several secondary schools benefitted from the basic 3D printing and Additive Manufacturing Training which was facilitated by the VUT SGSTP at their schools.



To name but a few, Thuto-Lore, Sizanani-Thusanang Comprehensive School in Sebokeng, Lebohang Secondary School in Sharpeville and Modise Secondary School in Mantserre, North West Province.

The Laboratories assist learners to benefit from interactive contact-based education through which they are able to conceptualize ideas and develop prototypes of products that they would like to develop. The VUT SGSTP is able to achieve this vision through the support of partners such as the Department of Basic Education, MerSETA, Technology Innovation Agency (TIA) to name a few. High school learners can also visit the Science Park through properly arranged school visits to explore other exciting programmes that are available.

Use your grade 11 or June matric results to apply online for admission for 2023. Don't wait for the publication of your final grade 12 results before you apply as there is no guarantee that space will be available in programmes that you wish to apply for.

Student Counselling and Support is committed to offering career counselling and guidance, therapeutic counselling and support, as well as spiritual/pastoral guidance and support.

The Student Counselling and Support Department offers the following services: The Career Centre Support Services include:

- Career guidance
- Psychometric testing
- Workplace preparation: CV writing, job hunting skills and interview skills
- Academic support: adjustment to student life, study skills/time management, exam preparation, dealing with exam and test anxiety and identification and support related to learning difficulties.

The Therapy and Counselling Services include:

Individual and group therapy support is available for you on psycho-social and/or emotional challenges you may experience. The aim is to assist you to effectively manage and cope with amongst others:

Student Counselling Procedures

- Student must bring their student cards or proof of registration to book an appointment

- Administrators will ensure that your information is correctly completed on the biographical form
- Support needs of all referred students will be screened and support offered accordingly
- In case of an emergency/crisis you will be assisted as soon as possible on the same day
- Emergency contact numbers for after-hours, weekends and public holidays, are posted on the front door of Student Counselling and Support

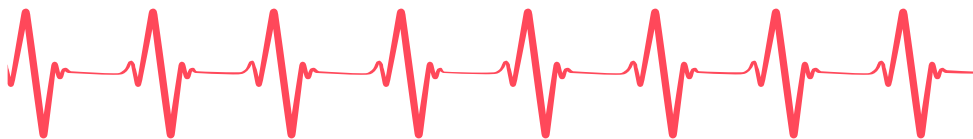

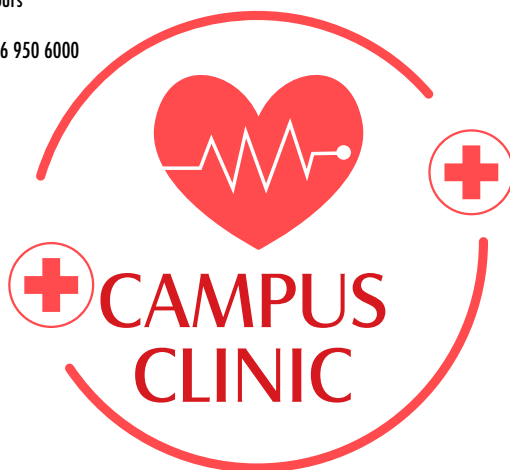

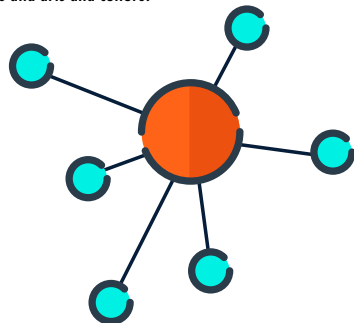
